The London Borough of Wandsworth invites you to a public drop-in to find out more about small sites at **Ashburton South** and **Ashburton Chartfield**, West Putney that could provide new council rent homes as part of the Homes for Wandsworth programme.

The identified areas present prime opportunities to deliver much-needed new homes for Wandsworth residents, through the development of under-used parts of the existing estates and areas that have fallen into disrepair. It is **not** the intention of any future plans to remove any existing homes on either estate. We are considering ideas to develop much-needed new homes for council rent, allowing people on the current

waiting list for Council housing to access a new high-quality home.

In addition to the new homes, we are also exploring opportunities to improve and enhance the existing open spaces, play spaces and community amenities for existing and new residents in **Ashburton South** and in **Ashburton Chartfield**.

We are in the early stages of the process and want to meet with the local community soon to find out your thoughts on your local area. Your local knowledge, thoughts and suggestions will be important to help us shape any proposals for each site by integrating your knowledge and ensuring that the very best schemes can be brought forward in the future.

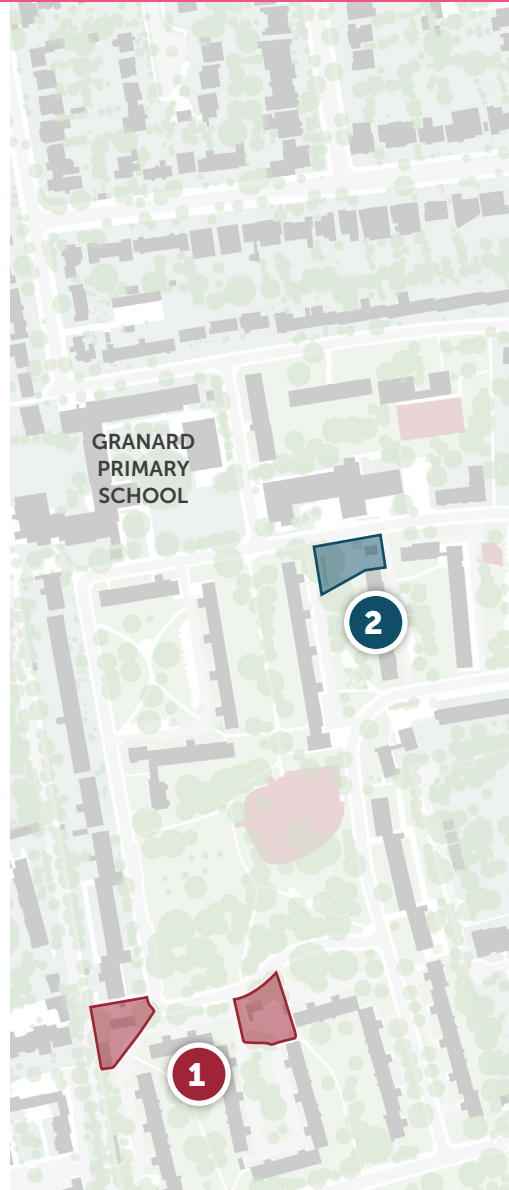
The Council is committed to investing in the Borough to deliver more affordable homes and has made a commitment to make all homes within the Homes for Wandsworth programme available for council rent, maximising the Council's stock of genuinely affordable housing.

There are currently over **11,000 applicants** on Wandsworth's housing waiting list, including **2,400 homeless applicants**. The Council is tackling the housing crisis through the ambitious Homes for Wandsworth programme.

As part of the Homes for Wandsworth programme, we are currently looking to develop small sites at **Ashburton South** and at **Ashburton Chartfield**, as shown on the plan opposite.

No existing homes will be demolished as part of our plans.
